Non-Banking Financial Institutions**

The **5th edition of MEDAFinance**, the regional conference on funding, banking and novel finance instruments will take place on the 16th & 17th of June 2019 under the auspices of the Prime Minister H.E. Dr. Moustafa Madbouly in Cairo, Egypt. It is organized by the German-Arab Chamber of Industry and Commerce (GACIC) in cooperation with ASCAME (Association of Mediterranean Chambers of Commerce and Industry), FEDCOC (Federation of Egyptian Chambers of Commerce), and CEEBA (Confederation of Egyptian European Business Associations).

Based on an extensive study that showcases the available funding opportunities, MEDAFinance 2019 will present and open new communication channels with donor and development agencies and IFI's, maximizing the use of the available grants and funding instruments in the MEDA region.

All major available instruments such as preferential lines of credits, soft loans, non-banking and novel financial instruments as well as grants and technical assistance available to Egyptian and Mediterranean and European companies will be presented.

MEDAFinance 2019 will promote proposal development within regional BSOs, spur cooperation between the EU and EUROMED BSOs and enable BSOs to offer top advisory services to their member SMEs in regards to possible funding and finance opportunities.

The workshops on day one shall equip EU and MED BSOs with the background of available programmes to enable them to draft international cooperation proposals. It will raise awareness of BSOs of the channels and the responsibilities of various funded programmes, as well as give the opportunity to mediate their needs to the decision makers in IFI. Workshop day No. 2 will focus on presenting funding opportunities, grants, technical assistance and credit lines for SMEs and BSOs. It will present a comprehensive and updated list of funding opportunities by donors, banks and other novel finance Instruments.
